

LBL Baking Information:

Recipe:

- Needs to be approved by Ms. Wright. Once your recipe is approved, changes will no longer be made. This help for planning purposes to make sure we don't have 10 on the same dish/dessert.
- You are responsible for purchasing ALL of your own baking ingredients (EXCEPT butter and milk).
- Pack as little as possible! For example, if you need one cup of sugar measure it at home and pack it in a zip-lock baggie please don't pack a five pound bag of sugar. Please label your baggie with what ingredient is in the bag.
- Pack all of your baking supplies in a Wal-Mart type grocery bag and place your name on the outside of the Wal-Mart bag.
- You need to bring ALL of your ingredients to Ms. Wright's room between Nov. 13- Nov. 15.
- Try to make everything you pack disposable so we don't have to tote baking supplies back home.

Tie-Dye:

- As a bonus activity, all bakers have the opportunity to tie-dye with Mrs. King.
- Please pack an article of clothing to tie-dye

Examples: white/light colored t-shirt, white/light colored apron, etc. (Please NO socks)
- Place your tie-dye materials in a Wal-Mart type grocery bag and place your name on the outside of the Wal-Mart bag.
- You need to bring ALL of your tie-dye materials to Ms. Wright's room between Nov. 13- Nov. 15.
