

Expectations for E-Learning days

The EVSC will conduct four E-learning days on March 12, April 16, April 30, and May the 14th. Below you can see the expectations for students, teachers and parents during these four school days.

Students will:

- Log into Google Classroom and participate in synchronous instruction through Google Meet
- Adhere to school behavior expectations for digital citizenship as if they were in school
- Request help from the teacher during the student support times
- Reserve 7:30am - 2:30 pm for the school day
 - Please do not schedule other things during the school day. You must be logged into your Google Meets during the designated times, as well as complete work assigned to you.
 - If a student has a study hall they do not need to sign in to that class.

Teachers will:

- Teach synchronously (online) during the 25-minute period
- Post assignments that extend beyond the whole group instruction
- Provide assistance to students who need extra help during student support hours. This might be in small groups or one on one

Parents will:

- Ensure that your student signs on and completes the needed assignments on these four days.

Attendance will be based on student's participation in Google Meet sessions along with completion of assigned work.
